## Origins

There are locations where the remnants of an oceanic plate is exposed at the earth's surface. The remains of the plate are usually exposed by uplift and deep weathering. Serpentine most often occurs at such places.

Volcanoes and earthquakes are often common feature in those places. New Zealand, which is on the very edge of the Australian tectonic plate and the Pacific tectonic plate is a such a location. In the South Island it appears with precious Nephrite Jade and the author collected his first specimen there in early 2007.

## Constituents

1. Magnesium – a fiery element with its tendency to burn easily and produce intense heat.
2. Silica is a fundamental element of the earth. Earth's crust is 59% Silica – it provides stability for all life.
3. Water – is integrated into the crystal - it is 13% by weight

## Sinuses

- From early stages in the proving I noticed chronic sinus congestion was much easier while carrying the stone.
- It was also effective with acute pain in the sinuses – ethmoid, frontal, maxillary and sphenoid.
- There was no associated infection, just congestion.

## Memory

- In 2016 I located Serpentine in NSW (specimen photo above)
- While carrying it there were striking errors of perception and expression – mistakes in speaking.
- Further indicators of its significance in memory loss:
  - o Mind goes blank as to what she is about to do
  - o Complete blank in the middle of sentence
  - o Forgetful of names
  - o Annoyed with self when can't remember things.
  - o Dream: Those with dementia who talk incoherently and irrelevantly

## **Tissues**

- I had the feeling of being heavy and unwilling to get out of bed as a result
- The work of Dr Camillo Leonardi (1502) espoused its power over dropsy.
- Used Serpentine to effectively cure this sensation
- There was also a clinical case where the feeling “like a sponge filled with water”; tiredness at 10 am and attraction to soft green was cured of this sensation.

## **The Psyche**

- Kind gentle and yielding or
- Resistant, volatile and angry when questioned.
- Procrastination – makes one ready to act
- Those who feel their mood enhanced by the enjoyment of sweet food, alcohol or unfettered sexual activity. They enjoy being ‘tipsy’.
- Increases gratitude for the good things in your life.

## **Personality typologies**

- it is Orthorhombic
- Characterised by visceral deeply held feeling
- Not so expressive
